RELIGIOUS LIBERTY & CONSCIENCE PROTECTION

The U.S. bishops have issued a statement on religious liberty entitled “Our First Most Cherished Liberty” which reviews multiple ways that religious liberty has been threatened – see bulletin insert. Furthermore, the bishops are calling for “**A Fortnight for Freedom,**” the two-week period from June 21 to July 4 – beginning with the feasts of St. Thomas More and St. John Fisher and ending with Independence Day.

Bishop Campbell will lead a diocesanwide celebration of Morning Prayer on June 30 at 9:30 a.m. in St. Joseph Cathedral. The Office for Social Concerns will be sponsoring a forum on religious liberty at 7:00 p.m. on June 27, at Immaculate Conception Parish in Columbus. Dr. Bill Murphy, professor of moral theology at the Josephinum, and Sr. Pauline Ross, OCarm, administrator of Mother Angeline McCrory Manor, will join Bishop Campbell as presenters.
