THE WORD

When I was in novitiate, our novice master once told us that he had been given the gift of a candle. The person who gave it to him noticed that it remained unlit on his table and asked, "Is something wrong with the candle that I gave you or don't you like it?" He answered, "Nothing is wrong with it, I like it very much. Why do you ask?" "Well," said his friend, "you haven't lit it and candles are meant to be lit." The point of the story was that gifts are to be used and shared, not simply admired and hoarded. It is a lesson that I've not forgotten in over forty years.

Jesus enters the upper room, breathes on those gathered, and gives them peace and the Holy Spirit. He tells them to use those gifts to forgive or retain sins. The gifts were given to be shared. Even when given as mighty wind and tongues of flame, the gift of the Spirit was given to be shared: "The Spirit enabled them to proclaim" (Acts 2:4). And people understood in their own languages! Paul tells us that "the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit" (1 Corinthians 12:7).

There are many gifts from the same Spirit. They are given to us to be shared and not kept to ourselves. The best way that we can affirm our own gifts and admire those of others is to use the gifts God has given us. We pray in today's Sequence, "Come, source of all our store! Come, within our bosoms shine." What gift or gifts has God given you in the power of the Spirit? How do you use them for the good of others, the Church, and the world?

- Reflect on and name the gifts that you've been given to do good in the name of the Holy Spirit.
- What helps you use your gifts and what holds you back?
